

The beginning...

The formation of the Quilt Guild of GreaterVictoria began when Susan Manning discovered that Judy Murrah was moving to Victoria. Her first thought was "Another quilter, at last!" After settling in Victoria in the fall of 1982, Judy called Susan, and they discussed the need for an organization to promote the art of quilting in Victoria. Judy taught classes at the Open Door and in January 1983, the two began talking seriously about beginning a guild.

Judy, Susan and Barbara Meyer (director of the Victoria Regional Museum Association) met. Barbara explained tax-exemption, funding, and a time and meeting place were selected. On March 16, 1983, thirteen women met in the O'Connor Gallery. Volunteers served as chairmen the first year and officers were elected for the first time in 1984.

Annual Quilt Show and Sampler Store in conjunction with the Quilt Show.

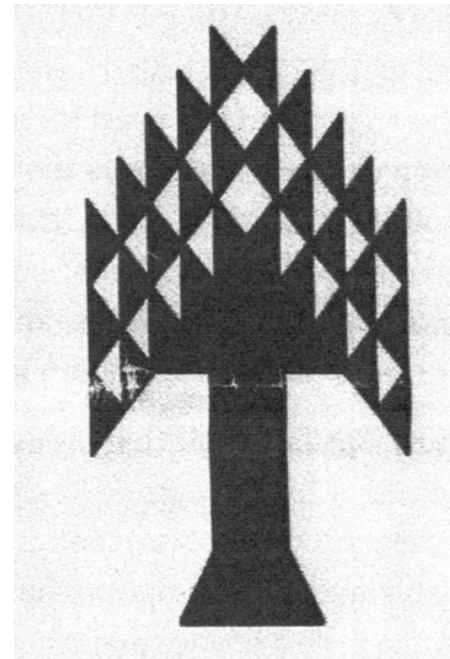
